

Instructions for when you arrive for the fall semester

COVID TESTING AND MANDATORY COMPLIANCE

- Complete the **Mason COVID Health Check** every day at go.gmu.edu/covidhealthcheck
- Get your **COVID test** on campus between the 3rd & 5th day of arriving to the U.S.
 - Go to a testing site (Johnson Center OR Fenwick Library A Wing) between 7:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.
 - Students who are under age 18 must have a parent/guardian complete the online minor consent form before getting tested at seerm.gmu.edu/consent-for-minors-or-dependents/
 - Check 'Messages' in the Health Services Patient Portal for test results

**If you test positive, Student Health Services will contact you with instructions*

COVID VACCINATION REQUIREMENT

**Fully vaccinated = 2 weeks (14 days) after the 2nd dose of a 2-dose series (i.e. Moderna or Pfizer vaccines) OR 2 weeks after a 1 dose vaccine (i.e. the Johnson & Johnson vaccine) authorized by the WHO or FDA*

- If you are **vaccinated** with a WHO or FDA-approved vaccine, then upload COVID-19 vaccination documentation to go.gmu.edu/UploadCOVIDVaccine
- If you are **not fully vaccinated** with a WHO or FDA-approved vaccine, then you must:
 - Complete quiet quarantine for 7 days
 - **On-campus residents** with a **single bedroom** can quiet quarantine in their private residence hall room
 - **On-campus residents** who **share a room** will need to complete their quiet quarantine at the Angel Cabrera Global Center or off-campus
 - **Off-campus students** will complete their quiet quarantine in their off-campus residence
 - Schedule your COVID vaccine appointment for the 7th day after your arrival to the United States; register at vaccine.gmu.edu
 - If you are on-campus resident, check 'Messages' in the Health Services Patient Portal for confirmation that your quiet quarantine has ended

**If you are living on-campus but quarantined at the Angel Cabrera Global Center or off campus, show this message at a Housing and Residence Life (HRL) Desk to check in to move into your residence hall room*

OTHER VACCINATION REQUIREMENT

If you have not uploaded your Tuberculin (TB) test result to the Patient Portal, please call 703-993-2831 to make an appointment with Student Health.

MOVING IN TO YOUR RESIDENCE HALL

Check in if you are living on the Fairfax campus and:

- Arriving on August 18-19 between 9 a.m. - 5 p.m., then check in at Eagle Bank Arena
- Arriving after August 20th between 9 a.m. - 5 p.m., then check in at your assigned residence hall
- Arriving after 5 p.m. and NOT fully vaccinated, then check in at Piedmont
- Arriving after 5 p.m. and FULLY vaccinated, then check in at Piedmont or Eisenhower, whichever is closest to your assigned residence hall
